Guideline for referral: Perioperative Cardiology Multi-disciplinary team

New cardiac issue/s identified at Anaesthetic review

(Examples of Preoperative cardiac Issues)

1. Cardiac Rhythm

New atrial or ventricular arrhythymias ECG abnormalities

2. Valvular Heart Disease

Significant valvular heart disease on echocardiogram and no recent follow up. Valvular heart disease and timing of non-cardiac surgery

3. Heart failure

Recent symptoms or hospitalisation Optimisation of management

4. Myocardial ischemia

New symptoms (angina, SOB, other) ECG changes Non-invasive imaging

5. Other

Discuss cardiac issue with consultant Anaesthetist

Has patient seen a cardiologist in past?

(eg. last 5 years)

Consider discussion with patients own cardiologist for further possible investigation and managment



Is surgery elective?

If elective surgery - consider referring patient back to GP for further investigation and management
If surgery is to be delayed: <u>MUST</u> discuss with surgical team
